Creating an iTunes Accounts for your child

You will need to create an iTunes Account – Apple ID – for yourself. If you already have your own Apple ID you can use it to create one for a child under the age of 13 from within your own account using Family Sharing. You will have complete control over which apps your child downloads. It will be linked to your own account, using the same payment method you use. Covers

It is recommended that you purchase a cover that extends around the outside of the iPad and also includes a cover that can be closed over the glass screen. This type of cover provides the best protection for the iPad if it is dropped. A 'screen protector' is a thin plastic film which can also be applied to the screen and provides additional protection.

Using the iPad

It's important to find a comfortable posture when using iPad, and to take frequent breaks. Use your lap, or a table, case, or dock accessory, to support iPad during use.

Handle the iPad with care, to maintain its appearance. If you're concerned about scratching or abrasion of the screen, you can use a case or a cover, sold separately.

The iPad is sensitive to heat – please do not leave in a car or in direct sunlight.

Reminder: the iPad is to be used only at home or at school and is not to be used whilst travelling in the car, bus etc.

Cleaning the iPad

To clean iPad, unplug all cables and turn off iPad (press and hold the Sleep/Wake button until the red slider appears, then slide the onscreen slider). Use a soft, slightly damp, lint-free cloth. Avoid getting moisture in openings. Don't use window cleaners, household cleaners, aerosol sprays, solvents, alcohol, ammonia, or abrasives to clean iPad. The iPad screen has an oleophobic coating; simply wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth to remove oil left by your hands. The ability of this coating to repel oil will diminish over time with normal usage, and rubbing the screen with an abrasive material will further diminish its effect and may scratch your screen.
